## Self-service photograph day pass

If you have a place booked in the Archives search room, you can purchase a one day self-service photography pass before you visit so you can take unlimited photographs on your visit with your own camera or camera phone.

If you have booked a microfilm session, this pass will also allow you to save copies of microfilm records to your memory stick. Please note, access to our microfilm copy machine will be shared with other searchroom users, so you may not have dedicated access to this machine for your entire visit.

## High Resolution Digital Scans

We are able to provide high resolution copies of the records we look after. Please note, not all records can be copied due to fragility and size. We will try to provide a suitable copy whilst considering the need to preserve the original for the future. Copyright law may, on occasion, prevent us from supplying a copy.

Your scan will be provided as a digital file. Our default format is a high resolution jpeg, but tiff format files can be provided on request for the same price. Some of our scanners will also allow a higher DPI than our standard settings (400 DPI), please contact us if you require this. Slides and negatives are scanned at 3000 DPI.

## Pre-scan flattening / conservation

Where an item is not suitable for scanning due to fragility, or is folded in such a way it would not produce a clear high quality scan, we will not be able to offer our copy service.

However, sometimes it is possible for us to ask our conservation team to flatten or conserve an item prior to scanning. In these cases there will be an additional charge.

## Certification Copies

A certified copy is a signed copy of the original entry in a document. Certified copies are usually requested for legal purposes.

If you require Tyne and Wear Archives to certify a document as a true and accurate copy of an original entry in a document in our collections, we can provide this for an additional cost of £5. Please note this will be in addition to the cost of the document digital scan itself.

If you wish to publish an image or sound file from any of our archives, you will need to seek permission and acknowledge Tyne and Wear Archives as the source. Please note this will be in addition to the cost of the digital scan / sound file upload itself.

Re-use of images and sound files is permitted where copyright permissions allow, or where you have received the permission of the copyright owner.
