Try nature art—find sticks, leaves, flowers and stones lying on the ground and use them to make your own amazing creations



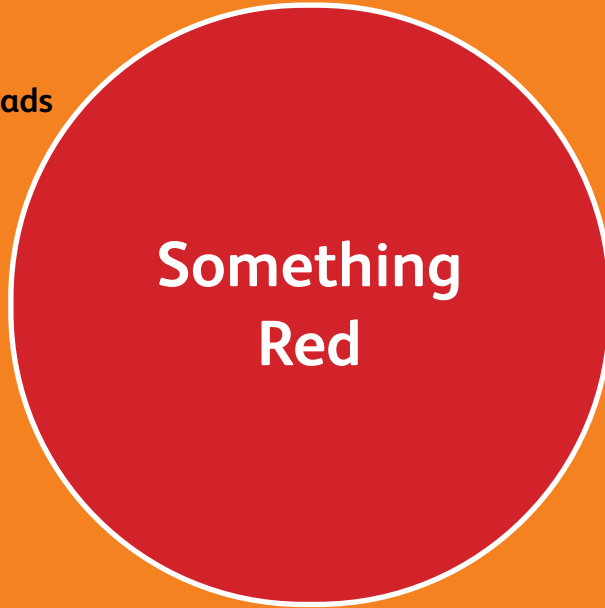
Can you find flowers, leaves, fruits or animals in every colour of the rainbow?

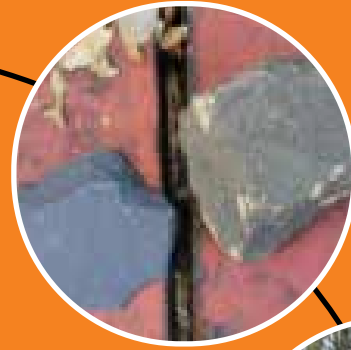
