

Sleepover Rules

What you will need to bring:

- Sleeping mat (not an airbed)
- Sleeping bag
- A pillow
- A torch
- Toiletries
- Additional water.

What to wear:

- Please arrive in the clothes you plan to sleep in and depart in as we have no changing space available
- Bring warm clothing as the museum is a big, old building and it can get cold
- Halloween fancy dress is encouraged but please have pyjamas on under your costumes as we have no adult changing spaces available
- Please wear shoes or slippers in the museum at all times.

Food and drinks:

- Snacks and drinks will be available to purchase during the event (in addition to the meals provided) but please do not eat outside the designated eating zones
- Tickets include a dinner and breakfast buffet – please let us know of any dietary requirements when booking. Menu to the dinner and breakfast buffet are:

Where you will be sleeping:

- Groups will be allocated a sleeping space on arrival at the museum so if you are planning to visit as a group please book under one name for all people in your party
- You will need to bring all of your own sleeping equipment – sleeping mat, sleeping and pillow
- Please note that no airbeds or tents are permitted
- We know this is a very exciting event, but we will begin bedtime at 10pm and have lights out at 11pm; please keep noise to a minimum between the hours of 11pm and 6am.

What facilities will be available:

- There will be limited washing facilities for teeth brushing and face washing, please be patient with each other when it comes to getting ready for bedtime and getting ready in the morning
- Please keep all valuables with you at all times, limited locker space is available in the front of the museum
- If you need a separate space for any medical or religious reasons, please let us know at the time of booking so we can arrange this for you.

Other rules and restrictions:

- No smoking or vaping
- No electrical appliances to be used or charged in the museum
- No aerosol deodorants to be used in the museum
- Please remember you are sleeping in a museum, it is important we keep objects safe and secure so please do not leave any litter behind after your stay with us

- 10pm: Storytime

- 6.30pm: wake up and start packing up, Planetarium shows will run every half hour from 6.30am until 8.30am
- 7am: Breakfast buffet until 8am
- 9.30am: Packed up ready to leave
- 10am: Depart the museum.
