- A BIG Question

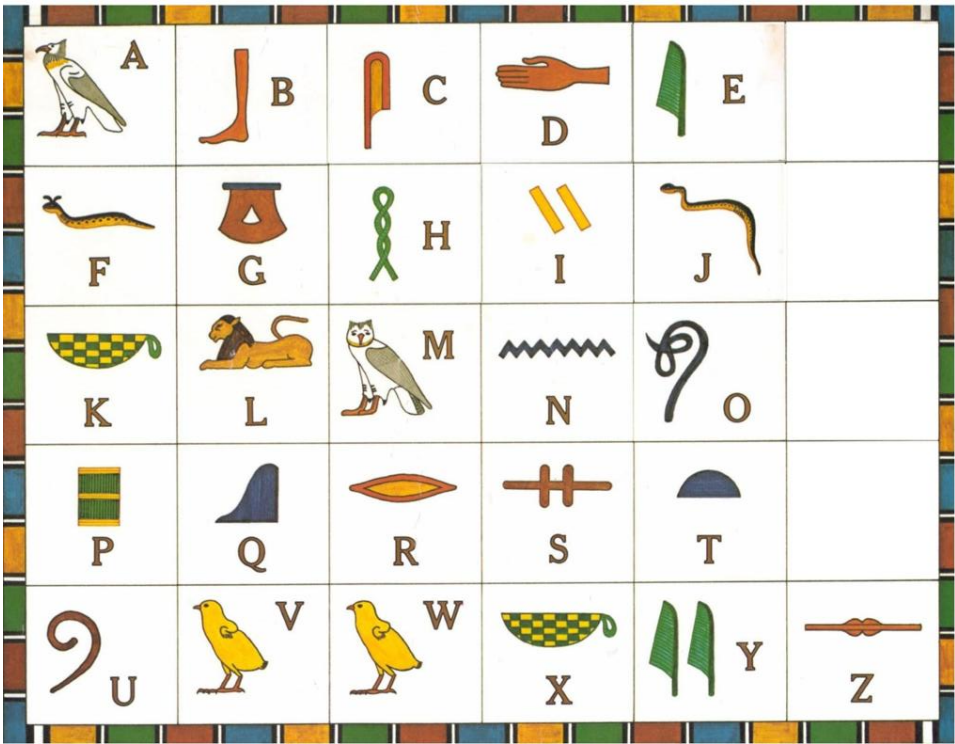

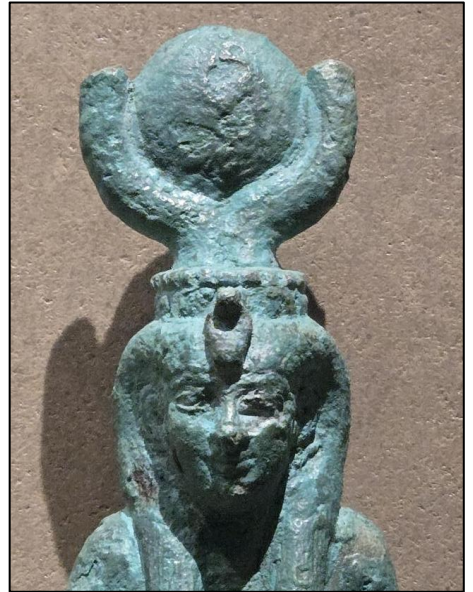

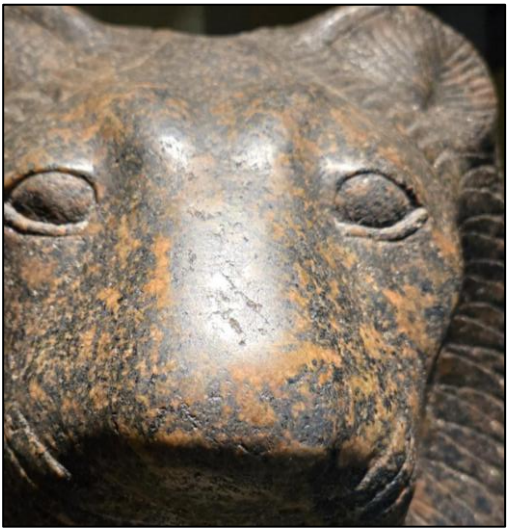


Hieroglyphics are the writing system that Ancient Egyptians used. Symbols or pictures were used for words and letters. Have a go at writing your name below.
