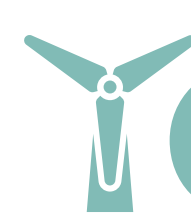
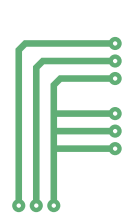
Technical Support for Manufacturing Units

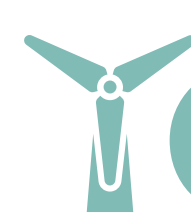
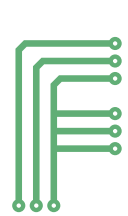
Quality Leader

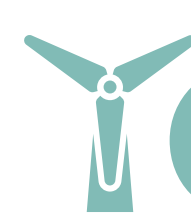
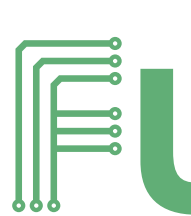
